Tell us about who you are, and why this grant is important to you. If you have been matched already, tell us about the child you're adopting. Let us know why you require financial assistance to complete the adoption. Be sure to address: any special considerations you would like the grant selection committee to know about; any past experience with adoption or foster care; why you have decided to build your family through adoption.

There is no minimum or maximum length requirement. However, you should keep in mind that the best way to increase your chances of receiving a grant is to include a meaningful personal statement.
